



PRIVACY POLICY Jonathan Shubs Educational Services, Unified Acupuncture Theory, UAT.training

I. Explanation

This Privacy Policy is based on article 13 of the General Regulation Data protection and contains the rights and obligations of the organization with regards to the external persons whose personal data they process mainly in the context of online sales and marketing of goods and services.

II. Policy model

This "Privacy Policy" regulates the processing of your personal data by the responsible person processing: Jonathan Shubs Educational Services, Avenue Louis Ruchonnet 2, 1003, Lausanne, Switzerland, hereinafter "JSES".

Read this Privacy Policy carefully because it contains essential information about how your personal data is processed. By providing your personal data on the Website www.unifiedacupuncturetheory.com and by providing the email addresses mentioned on this website Personal data, you declare that you have taken note of this Privacy Policy and expressly agree, as well as with the processing itself.

Article 1 - General

1.1. JSES lives the "Law of 8 December 1992 on the protection of privacy with respect to the processing of personal data "after, as amended by the Law of 11 December 1998 as well as the anti-spam provisions of Book XII of the Economic Code Law concerning the "law of the electronic economy".

1.2. JSES is also in line with the European Regulation through current Privacy Policy 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of personal data.

Article 2 - Personal data

2.1. Personal data that you communicate to us:

- ☑ Category 1, without registration: your IP address
- ☑ Category 2: your profile name, password, e-mail address, login details
- ☑ Category 3: at registration: when you subscribe to our newsletter: your e-mail address;
- ☑ Category 4: your address details as a result of placing an order.

Article 3 - Purposes of the processing

3.1. General purposes:

The JSES will only collect the Personal Data collected from you for the following purposes:

- Category 1: providing and improving this Website and recording Personal data for anonymous statistics, showing the identity of specific persons or companies can not be traced, with the legal basis the legitimate interests of JSES to continuously update its Website and improve services;
- Category 2: the management of your account on this Website with a view to its use from our JSES website, with the legal implementation of an agreement you were asked, and, if indicated by you, also sending direct marketing, with your explicit prior consent or as legal basis legitimate interest;
- Category 3: sending you newsletters with your explicit, legal base prior permission or legitimate interest.
- Category 4: the delivery and invoicing of services ordered by you, with the legal basis providing a service that was requested by you.

You are not obliged to release Your Personal Data, but you understand that for certain services it becomes impossible when you refuse processing.

3.2. Direct marketing:

The personal data will also be used for forwarding us course offer via a newsletter.

If you no longer wish to receive our course offers, you can do so at any time free of charge by clicking on the provided unsubscribe link at the bottom of each promotional e-mail. Or by sending an email to contact@uat.training.

3.3. Transfer to third parties:

In the event of a complete or partial reorganization or transfer of activities of JSES in which it reorganizes, transfers, ceases or if JSES goes bankrupt, this may mean your data will be transferred to new entities or third parties through which the business activities of JSES are executed in whole or in part.

JSES will make reasonable efforts to inform you in advance that JSES discloses information to said third party, but you also acknowledge that this is not at all circumstances are technically or commercially feasible.

JSES will not sell, rent, distribute or otherwise sell your Personal Data make commercially available to third parties, except as described above or without your prior consent.

3.4. Legal requirements:

In rare cases, JSES may register your Personal Data pursuant to a court order or to comply with other mandatory laws or regulations and must be disclosed. JSES will reasonably attempt to inform you in advance in this respect, unless subject to legal restrictions.

Article 4 - Duration of the processing

The personal data is stored and processed by us for a period that is necessary in function of the purposes of the processing and in function of the contractual relationship between JSES and you.

Article 5 - Your rights

5.1. Right of access and inspection:

You have the right to receive free access to your personal data at any time, as well of the use we make of your personal data.

5.2. Right of improvement, deletion and limitation:

You are free to decide whether to share your personal data with JSES. In addition, you are always entitled to request that we supplement or improve or delete your personal data. You acknowledge that in case of refusal of communication or request for removal of personal data, certain services and products are not available.

You may also request to limit the processing of your Personal Data.

5.3. Right of resistance:

You also have a right of opposition to the processing of your personal data for serious and legitimate reasons.

In addition, you always have the right to oppose the use of personal data for direct marketing purposes; in such a case you do not have to give reasons.

5.4. Right of free data transfer:

You have the right to use Your Personal Data processed by Us obtain and / or transfer it to other responsible persons.

5.5. Right of withdrawal of consent:

Insofar as the processing is based on your prior consent, you have the right to withdraw that consent.

5.6. Exercising your rights:

5.7. Automatic decisions and profiling:

The processing of your personal data does not include profiling and you will not be subject to automated decisions.

5.8. Right to complain:

In no case can JSES be held liable for any direct or indirect damage arising from an incorrect or unlawful use by a third party of the personal data.

6.3. You must comply with the safety regulations at all times, including by not every allowed access to your login and code. You are therefore solely responsible for use made from the website of your computer, IP address and your identification data, as well as for confidentiality.

Article 7 - Access by third parties

7.1. In order to process your personal data, you grant access to your personal data for our outsourced processes.
